

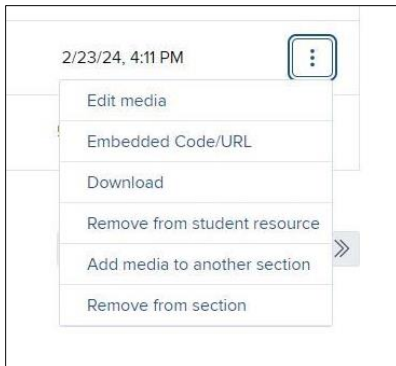


Creating a Media Assignment

Connect Media Assignments help ensure students view recorded lecture material. The same Connect functionality of "Creating your own question" will apply. These assignments allow an instructor to add questions to an assignment, set Start and Due dates, and provide all the features of a traditional Connect assignment.

Before we create the assignment, we are going to copy the preferred media file URL. On the All Media page, locate the recording you wish to share from your assignment. Use the search function if you know the name of the recording.



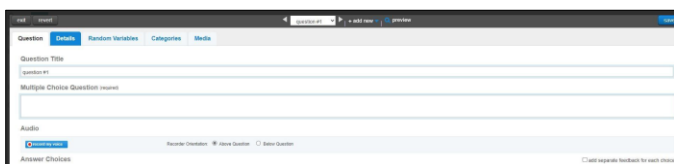
Click the three vertical dots, to the right of the recording and select "Embedded Code/UR". Click "Copy URL" from the pop-up window. At this stage, open a notepad application and

paste the URL. Close the "Share Recording" URL window. On the Notepad, copy the following URL – `<p>Play the Video</p>`

The text between the "double quote", is where your media URL will eventually be pasted.

On your Connect Page, click the "Assignments" tab and then "Add assignment". Click "Question Bank". Click the drop-down menu from the popup window and select "Create your own question".

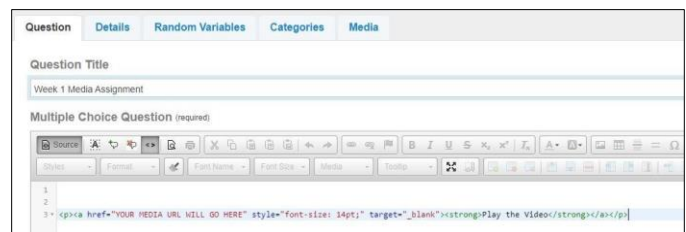
In this example we are going to select "Multiple Choice". This will launch the Question Editor.



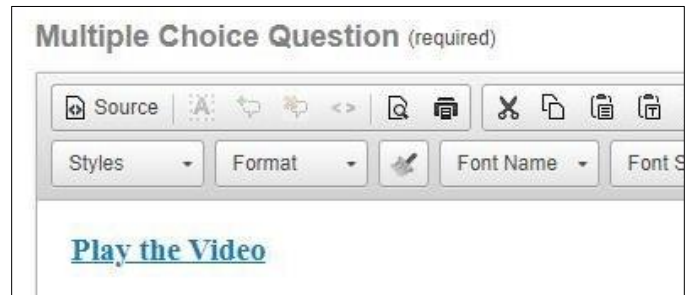
Enter a Question Title.

Click into the window below "Multiple Choice Question (required)" and then go back to your Notepad and copy the URL code you paused and wrote down earlier.

Click in the question window and click the "Source" button top left of the editing toolbar. Click into the text box, press enter twice and paste the code.



Copy the media URL from your notepad. Go back to the Question Editor in Connect and highlight the text YOUR MEDIA URL WILL GO HERE. Paste the media URL between the double quotes – **do not delete the double quotes**. Click the "Source" button to return to regular text editing functionality.



Here is where you can type a multiple-choice question and then add question responses in the 'Distractor' boxes. The question default is 4 distractor boxes so if you will not use all of them the extras must be deleted. Click Save in the Top right of the page. Then click Exit at the top left of the page.

At this stage, you may add additional questions from the test bank, or create your own questions based around the video. You may also proceed to the next steps of your assignment Policies and finish creating your assignment.
