


Conducting a Connect Poll

Video Walkthrough: CLICK TO VIEW



To begin, click the polling tab on your section dashboard. Polling options are available under the three dots drop down menu. To share a poll with your students you will either select Start Poll or Student Poll Access. To share the polling info with students before class, click Student Poll Access.




There are three ways to share your poll with students. First, select the **Copy URL** button to copy the URL for that specific poll. You can then share the link in a class message, post the link in your LMS, or email it for students to access. The second option is by **copying the Poll ID** and sharing it with students either before class or at the start of class. Students can navigate to the link shown and search for the poll using the Poll ID. Lastly, to start the poll only when class starts, use the **QR code** for students to scan with their mobile devices.

When it is time to conduct a poll, select Start Poll under the three dots drop down menu. You will see the same poll sharing info you saw previously, however here is where you will click Start Poll to begin. You may leave the question open for as long as desired. On the right side of the screen, you will see Responses. As students submit answers to this question, the response counter will be updated every 10 seconds.

To close the question, select Close Question. Students will no longer be able to submit answers for this question. If you choose to display the correct answer, it will appear. Your poll results will be shown on the right side of your screen, including the number of students who responded and percentage of total respondents.

To see a more detailed response, select the "Question Options" dropdown menu. Select View Detailed Results. Within the student results report, you will see students sorted by name. In the Filter by response dropdown, filter all results to any answer choice. Students who do not respond to the question will still be shown in the reports list of students. By selecting the question details option, you will be presented with the question prompt and answer choices for reference.



If you would like to reopen a question, select Question Options and click reopen question. Note that reopening a question WILL RESET student responses for the question and delete the original results.

If you would like to retain the original results, do not reopen a question, but rather duplicate the poll. To do this, close the question and select End Poll and go back to the Polling tab. Duplicate the poll by clicking the three dots drop down menu and selecting Duplicate Poll. Run the newly duplicated poll to keep the original results.
