- Which circle did you fill in for item 1? (Call on a student.) *B*.
- Item 2? (Call on a student.) C.
- Item 3? (Call on a student.) A.
- Item 4? (Call on a student.) D.
- Item 5? (Call on a student.) B.
- Item 6? (Call on a student.) B.
- 4. Here's the answer for item 7. (Write on the board: Miguel said, "Tell Ben's brother I can't play baseball.")

5. Read your answer for item 8. (Call on individual students. Accept answers that are consistent with the story.) Example:

It was Saturday, and Todd and Ray didn't know what to do. Finally, Todd said, "<u>Let's go see a movie</u>."

But when the boys got to the theater, the movie had already started. So they walked around the town.

Ray said, "<u>Let's buy some ice</u> <u>cream</u>." So they went to the store to buy some ice cream.

Todd said, "<u>I'll pay for it</u>." He pulled out his wallet and looked inside. It was empty. He was very surprised.

"<u>What's the matter</u>?" Ray asked. Todd said, "I had ten dollars in my wallet this morning. <u>Now it's gone</u>."
